### Program Highlights

The role of state governments in delivering a low carbon future will be the focus of the National Environmental Law Association's conference in March next year, a hot topic since the federal government introduced a carbon price. To start, world leading climate change lawyer Professor Michael Gerrard will explain international trends in regulating carbon emissions (by video link).



A session on **What's the role of state governments in promoting renewable energy?** is sure to provide insights with Roger Wilkins (pictured), who led the strategic review of climate change programs for the Commonwealth Government in 2008, Anthea Harris, CEO of the Climate Change Authority, and Robert Stokes, NSW Parliamentary Secretary for Renewable Energy.

A session on **Can regulation of energy markets and Renewable Energy Targets achieve sustainability?** will look at energy market regulation in the UK and EU, and in Australia. With Dr Aileen McHarg, University of Strathclyde, Glasgow and the Grattan Institute's Tony Wood, Energy Program Director.



A highlight of the conference is a **debate hosted by Jon Faine on Invisible hand or hands on: government's role in a clean energy future**. It's the climate change policy debate of the year with the Hon Mark Dreyfus QC MP, Parliamentary Secretary for Climate Change and Energy Efficiency, the Hon Greg Hunt, the shadow Minister for Climate Action, Environment and Heritage and Senator Larissa Waters, the Australian Greens Senator for Queensland.
